








5th Annual NHYC / SDYC Islands Race







From January 27 – February 1, 2014, ISAF Sailing World Cup Miami returns to the waters of Biscayne Bay, bringing together the world's top Olympic and Paralympic class competitors. Marking the 25th running of the event, the regatta is the North American highlight on the winter circuit for sailors who are campaigning for the 2016 Olympic and Paralympic Games. Organized by US Sailing, the event is the third stop on the 2013-14 ISAF Sailing World Cup, an annual, world-class series for Olympic and Paralympic sailing.

The regatta is open to the events and equipment chosen by ISAF for the 2016 Olympic and Paralympic Sailing Competitions, which will be held in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil from August 5-21 and September 7-18, respectively. The 10 Olympic classes are: Laser Radial (women), Laser (men), Finn (men), Men's RS:X, Women's RS:X, 49er (men), Men's 470, Women's 470, Nacra 17 (mixed) and 49er FX (women). Paralympic classes included in the 2014 regatta are: 2.4mR (open, able and disabled), SKUD-18 (mixed crew, disabled) and Sonar (open, disabled).







SNIPE WORLDS MERCHANDISE

2009 Snipe Worlds Race Day #5

San Diego, CA (September 11, 2009) – Shifty breeze and light cloud cover greeted Snipe World Championship contenders on this final day of racing at the San Diego Yacht Club. Despite having to change and shorten each of the 2 races today, all time requirements were met in accordance with the Snipe class rules, and sailors were able to meet the 11-race goal for the event.

The final two races saw a few positions in the top 10 shuffle around, but the Brazilians finished strong with 3 teams in the top 6. Other notable finishes were the Spanish team of Palop and Pascual, securing 2nd place in the regatta after a tough race 10, finishing the day with a 4th place finish. The Japanese team of Nakamura and Shiraishi started the day off great with a bullet, but wasn't enough to hold the American team Rodriguez and Place at bay, giving the Americans a 3rd place finish moving the Japanese to 4th.

The 2009 Snipe World Championship was won in race 10 by the Brazilian team Bruno Amorim and crew Dante Bianchi. Amorim and Bianchi had to finish in the top 10 in race 10 to take home the Commodore Hub E. Isaacks Trophy, and their 5th place finish did just that, but that wasn't enough. Amorim and Bianchi then did a true victory lap and won the final race of the regatta.







BACKGROUND



The love of sport in Australia is undeniable and Victoria has long been held as the 'Sporting Capital' of this country. Before the America's Cup in 1851, before Australia won The Ashes in 1891-92, before the first Davis Cup in 1900 and before the first Melbourne Cup was run in 1861 and later won by Phar Lap in 1930, there was the Festival of Sails.

Mackinac Trophy

More formally known from its engraving as the Chicago-Mackinac Trophy but referred to as "The Bowl", this grand and intricate silver punch bowl was donated in 1927 by Commodore George Woodruff as the second permanent trophy for the Mackinac Race.

When the Mackinac Race resumed after World War I, it was dominated by the Universal Q Class, and the howl from the cruising boats resulted in the establishment of two divisions along with this very generous donation from Commodore Woodruff. From 1927 to 1951 it was alternated with the Mackinac Cup as the trophy for the Cruising Division or the Universal (Racing) Division. By 1951 the Universal Division of Q's had dwindled to just 7 boats while the Cruising Division had grown to a then enormous number of 51 yachts. 1952 was the first year of a First Division and Second Division fleet configuration, arranged essentially as the larger boats and the smaller boats. The Mackinac Trophy continued to be alternated between the two divisions until 1971 when the Mackinac Committee chose to offer four divisions with no overall award so the Clinch and Ritchie Trophies were also offered as division trophies until 1977, when the race reverted to two divisions. Designed as a bowl, the Mackinac Trophy

has also been used along side the Mackinac Cup for service of champagne by the winners to their competitors at the traditional fall banquet. How the Mackinac Committee explained in 1971 to the division winners of the Ritchie or Clinch Trophies that their trophies did not hold champagne may have been the reason for the reversion to two divisions in 1987.

The silversmithing of the Mackinac Trophy should not be missed. At the feet of the Native American scouts are turtles, the Native American name for Mackinac Island being "Michilimackinac" or Land of the Great Turtle. Commodore Woodruff provided a complete explanation of the symbols on the trophy in a letter to the club which you can find here.
